

Richard Hunter's Huntersounds RP360 Patch Set V18

The patches in this set were designed using the Audix Fireball V mic.
That doesn't mean they only sound good with the Fireball!

We have used this set with other mics as well, and the sound is different, just as it would be if you changed the mic with a "real" amp. Mics have character--no mic has an infinitely variable sound. Different mics and mic'd sounds are also associated with certain musical styles and social/emotional contexts. In other words, you need to switch mics sometimes to get a sound that's appropriate to a given style. That's how important the mic is to the sound of the overall chain.

Many of our customers use different mics and love what they hear. We use a 545SD and Bottle o' Blues with our RP patches, and they each have a definite sound and musical/social context.

Use whatever mic you like! Just keep in mind that the patches will sound different with different mics, just as a "real" amp would.

LAYOUT

The general layout of patches in this set is:

70 patches ranging from basic amp'd or direct tones without FX to very electronic sounding timbres.

Patches are grouped loosely around themes, e.g. amp'd rock and blues, Acoustic sounding, with vibrato, with rotating speaker, basic amp without FX, etc. The remaining 30 patch locations in the User area are set up with a graphic EQ configured for harmonica and a noise gate; these are two essential building blocks for almost any patch.

Naming conventions

In order to get as much usable information as possible into a 6-character display, I've named patches using the following conventions:

First two letters: amp model; CH for Champ, TD for Tweed Deluxe, BA for Tweed Bassman, DI for Direct, etc.

Next 2-3 letters: main effect used; DEL or DL for Delay, REV or RV for Reverb, 8D for Octave Down, 8U for Octave up, MXF for MX Flanger, etc.

The name ends with W when the WAH effect can be used.

Some names just give you the essence of the patch, e.g. "TuffSI" means a tough slide guitar sound, "Big Pearl" means a patch with Pearl chorus.

Sorry that the patch names are in effect coded.

IU wanted to get in as much info about the components of a sound as possible.

Pedal

Make SURE to work the pedal for every sound to see what it does.

I recommend that you set the pedal (using procedures described in the manual) to ensure that the Wah does NOT engage unless you really want it to.

A trigger level in the neighborhood of 111-115 will probably do the job.

In general, the pedal is assigned to SOMETHING in every patch I create, and pushing the pedal down makes the linked effect more intense.

Stomp mode

When the RP360 is on STOMP mode, the footswitches control ModFX or Distortion, Delay, and Reverb, in that order, from left to right.

Stomp mode is very cool when you want to dramatically alter the sound quickly. Each footswitch turns a particular effect on and off.

In Stomp mode you can't change patches without turning the big knob on the front panel, so you should only use Stomp when you're not going

to need to change patches frequently or quickly.
 Check the manual to see how you turn Stomp mode on.
 Hint: push the button marked SYSTEM.
